Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Ironton, State and County aforesaid, at 4:00 p.m., on the 26th day of August, 2019, at the City Hall in said City, at which citizens may be heard on the property tax rates proposed to be set by the City of Ironton, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri. The tax rates shall be set to produce the revenues which the budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019, show to be required from the property taxes. Each tax rate is determined by dividing the amount required by the current assessed valuation; the result is multiplied by 100 so the rate will be expressed in cents per \$100 valuation.

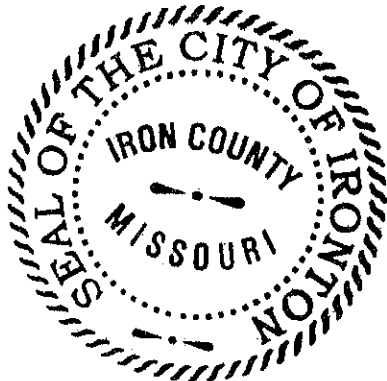
The proposed tax rates for 2019 per \$100 assessed valuation represent rates determined in accordance with §137.073 RSMo, and Article X, Section 22, Missouri Constitution. These sections of the Statutes and Constitution regulate the maximum tax rate after the assessed valuation of property is equalized.
